- No experience necessary

- National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) certification, sponsored and paid for by the City of Henderson
- A background check, paid for by the City of Henderson

The power of NYSCA certification and membership

- Provides \$2,000,000 excess liability insurance, and \$250,000 excess accident/medical insurance for injuries sustained while performing coaching duties

NYSCA certification is through the National Alliance for Youth Sports (NAYS), a nonprofit organization committed to making the sports experience safe, fun, and healthy for all children. The organization trains volunteer coaches worldwide and more than 2 million are currently certified.
