

ORDINANCE NO. 3364

(Amend Henderson Municipal Code Section 2.50.315 – Blue Ribbon Commission on Educational Excellence and Youth Opportunity)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON, NEVADA, TO AMEND SECTION 2.50.315 – BLUE RIBBON COMMISSION ON EDUCATIONAL EXCELLENCE AND YOUTH OPPORTUNITY - OF THE HENDERSON MUNICIPAL CODE.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3211 was established on September 2, 2014; and
- WHEREAS, changes are required in order to manage the number of members of the commission; and
- WHEREAS, changes are required in order to establish the number of student members to ensure increased participation from each school serving the Henderson area; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada, does ordain:

SECTION 1. Section 2.50.315 - Blue Ribbon Commission on Educational Excellence and Youth Opportunity is hereby amended as follows.

2.50.315 - Blue Ribbon Commission on Educational Excellence and Youth Opportunity.

A. Establishment. There is established, pursuant to city ordinance no. 1398, the blue ribbon commission on educational excellence and youth opportunity (blue ribbon commission).

B. Purpose. The blue ribbon commission is established for the purpose of (i) reviewing local, regional and national issues concerning excellence in education and opportunities for the development of youth in local communities, and (ii) recommending the implementation and/or promotion of those approaches that show the greatest promise for the enhancement of the quality of life for all youth within the city of Henderson. The duties of the commission shall include the following:

1. Review city involvement in supporting education and the development of youth;
2. Assist the Clark County School District in efforts to develop constructive working relationships with those organizations and sectors of the community that are concerned with promoting quality education; and
3. Submit a report to the city council for consideration at the second city council meeting in May, setting forth the commission's efforts, results and future plans.

C. Membership. The Henderson blue ribbon commission on educational excellence and youth opportunity shall consist of a minimum of 15 but no more than 21 members to be nominated by the mayor and confirmed by a vote of the city council to serve for such terms as the council may subscribe at the time of appointment. The blue ribbon commission members shall reside, work, or attend school within the city of Henderson, except for

members who represent a specific group or organization, and shall consist of:

1. At least half plus one of the membership shall be students from area high schools.
2. At least one [, **but no more than two,**] representative[s for] *from* each participating high school (public or private) serving the Henderson area.
3. At least one adult representative of the Clark County School District.
4. At least one adult representative from the Henderson area business community.
5. At least one adult representative from the Henderson area community organizations.

Terms of office for adult members shall run concurrent with the mayor's term of office. Term of office for student members shall be for all years that such students attend high school, expiring July 31 after their final year in high school.


D. Meetings; bylaws. The blue ribbon commission shall adopt bylaws establishing meeting times and procedural rules necessary for the efficient conduct of its business.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, provision or portion of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or provisions of this Ordinance or their applicability to distinguishable situations or circumstances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Henderson, Nevada, in conflict herewith are repealed and replaced as appropriate.

SECTION 4. A copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the office of the City Clerk, and notice of such filing shall be published once by title in the Review Journal, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Henderson, at least ten (10) days prior to the adoption of said Ordinance, and following approval shall be published by title (or in full if the Council by majority vote so orders) together with the names of the Councilmen voting for or against passage for at least one (1) publication before the Ordinance shall become effective. This Ordinance is scheduled for publication on October 7, 2016, in the Review Journal.


