

In case of an occupational injury/illness/exposure... initial steps

- Inform your on-duty supervisor immediately
- Call 267-4911 (ask for the Fire Battalion Chief) if an exposure has occurred
- Complete a C-1 form (available online) within 7 days
- You have 90 days from the date of injury to seek treatment
- If medical treatment is needed you must use one of the approved medical facilities and complete a C-4
- Complete any additional forms noted on the Workers' Compensation checklist, as applicable.
- Contact your supervisor immediately with your physician's return to work recommendations. Your supervisor will have instructions for you.
- Email initial injury docs immediately to: PD EMPLOYEE INJURY GROUP
