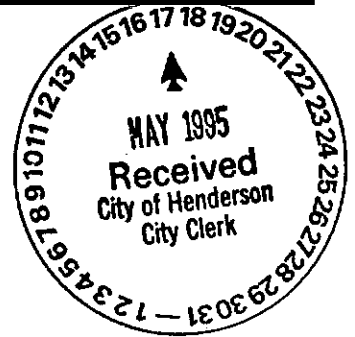


1995 PRIMARY and GENERAL ELECTIONS REPORTING PERIOD NO. 3

- Report No. 1 — Due April 17, 1995
- Report No. 2 — Due May 22, 1995
- Report No. 3 — Due August 15, 1995

Report No. 3 covers the remaining period from May 18, 1995 through July 6, 1995, inclusive. This report must include: an itemization of contributions in excess of \$500 and contributions which have been made cumulatively in excess of \$500; a total of all contributions less than or equal to \$500; and all expenditures made during the reporting period. It must also contain totals from all three reporting periods.

NOTE: All reports MUST be filed on the forms prescribed by the City Clerk. Additional sheets may be photocopied as indicated.

Disposition of Unspent Contributions

Who Must File: Every candidate -- whether elected, defeated or withdrawn -- for a state, district, county, city or township office at a primary, general or special election must dispose of contributions which were received but remained unspent. (It is unlawful for a candidate to spend money received as a campaign contribution for his personal use.)

Where to File: A report of the amount and disposition must be filed with the Secretary of State no later than 5 p.m. on the date due. You may file the report in person or by certified mail. If certified mail is used, the date of mailing shall be deemed the date of filing. Every candidate must send or deliver this form to:

FILING DEADLINES

If You Are NOT Elected -- not later than the 15th day of the second month after your defeat or withdrawal from a race. (NOTE: the Secretary of State's interpretation of this statute extends the reporting requirement to candidates who withdraw from a race before a primary, general or special election.)

If You Are Elected -- not later than the 15th day of the second month after your election. And, as a public officer you must file during your term not later than January 15th of each year, beginning the year after your election.

- (3) Contribute the money to:
 - (a) The campaigns of other candidates for public office or for the payment of debts related to their campaigns;
 - (b) A political party;
 - (c) A person or group of persons advocating the passage or defeat of a question or group of questions on the ballot; or
 - (d) Any combination of persons or groups set forth in the subparagraphs of #3;
- (4) Donate the money to any tax-exempt nonprofit entity; or
- (5) Dispose of the money in any combination of the methods provided above.

Every candidate who is not elected shall:

- (1) Return the unspent money to contributors;
- (2) Contribute the money to:
 - (a) The campaigns of other candidates for public office or for the payment of debts related to their campaigns;
 - (b) A political party;
 - (c) A person or group of persons advocating the passage or defeat of a question or group of questions on the ballot; or
 - (d) Any combination of persons or groups set forth in the subparagraphs of #2;
- (3) Donate the money to any tax-exempt nonprofit entity; or
- (4) Dispose of the money in any combination of the methods provided above.
