A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HENDERSON, NEVADA, STATING ITS SUPPORT FOR, AND
PARTICIPATION IN, THE UNITED STATES CENSUS BUREAU'S
CENSUS 2020 CAMPAIGN.

WHEREAS, the decennial census is required by Article 1, Section 2 of the Constitution of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the census presents a once-a-decade snapshot of the population and changing demographics of every community in the State of Nevada; and

WHEREAS, residents of the City of Henderson have a tremendous amount to gain through the decennial census process, given the remarkable growth our city has experienced over the last several decades; and

WHEREAS, that growth means more representation in the Nevada State Legislature and more per-capita dollars, ensuring that our community gets its fair share of federal funding; and

WHEREAS, a recent analysis by the George Washington Institute of Public Policy indicated that every Nevada resident missed by the decennial census reflects \$1,611 in lost per-capita federal funding per year; and

WHEREAS, businesses, community groups, and governments throughout the country are coming together over the next twelve months to form "Complete Count Committees" and educate their fellow Nevadans on the importance of participation and the thousands of job opportunities the census represents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada that:

SECTION 1 The City will support and participate in the United States Census Bureau's Census 2020 Campaign and will collaborate in regional efforts for developing the Southern Nevada Complete Count Committee.




