

RESOLUTION NO.4347
(Setting forth findings and determinations required by the Clark County
Crime Prevention Act of 2016)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HENDERSON,
NEVADA, ADOPTING FINDINGS REGARDING UTILIZATION OF REVENUE
GENERATED BY THE CLARK COUNTY CRIME PREVENTION ACT OF
2016.

WHEREAS, AB1 of the 30th Special Session of the Nevada Legislature authorized the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada, to increase the sales and use tax for the purposes of employing and equipping additional police officers for police departments located within Clark County, including the Henderson Police Department (the "Clark County Crime Prevention Act of 2016" or "Act"); and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada, held a public hearing to present its plan for implementation of the proposed tax, and adopted Ordinance No. 4447 to impose such tax to be effective on April 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2017, the City of Henderson adopted Resolution No. 4248 establishing a Crime Prevention Special Revenue Fund to account for the revenues received that are designated to be used to employ and equip additional police officers for the City; and

WHEREAS, AB1 prohibits the use of revenue generated by the tax to replace or supplant existing funding for police departments; and

WHEREAS, AB1 requires the Henderson City Council ("City Council") to make certain determinations and findings consistent with requirements of the Act before it can approve an expenditure of money allocated to the Henderson Police Department ("HPD") from the proceeds of the tax; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make certain findings and determinations in accordance with the Act for the fiscal year 2019-2020 ("FY 2020"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Henderson, Nevada:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the provisions of the Act, the City Council does hereby determine and find as follows:

- A. The proposed use of the money conforms to all provisions of the Act;
- B. The proposed use of the money will not replace or supplant existing funding for the HPD.

- i. This determination is supported by the finding that the amount approved for expenditure by the City Council for the General Fund support of the HPD for FY 2020, not including any money allocated to or expended by the HPD pursuant to the provisions of the Act, is \$102,147,240 or 5.6% greater than the General Fund amount approved for expenditure for the support of the HPD in the immediately preceding fiscal year.
- ii. The following reasons support the findings set forth above:
 - a. The General Fund expenditure budget of the HPD increased \$5,442,736 or 5.6% from the FY 2019 Final Budget to the FY 2020 Final Budget.
- C. The proposed use of the money will not be the payment of salary or any increase in salary for any person who is employed by the HPD before October 1, 2016; and
- D. The proposed use of the money is based upon a consideration of the distribution of the population within the area of the City of Henderson served by the HPD and the distribution of calls for service within the area of the City of Henderson served by the HPD.

SECTION 2. All actions of staff heretofore taken in furtherance of this Resolution are hereby ratified and approved.

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
