ADJUSTMENTS TO YOUR MONTHLY WATER AND SEWER BILL

WATER SERVICE AND VOLUME CHARGES

Monthly water rates consist of a service charge based on meter size, plus a volume consumption charge based on a fourtier rate structure to encourage conservation. Lake Mead's water levels remain near historic lows, requiring continued water conservation efforts to protect critical water levels. The following schedules outline the formerly approved and newly approved monthly service and volume charges for 2024. New approved charges are effective January 1, 2024. A typical single-family residential customer served by a 3/4" meter and consuming 7,500 gallons of water will see a \$1.71 increase in their monthly water bill. Monthly charges are based on a 30-day month.
