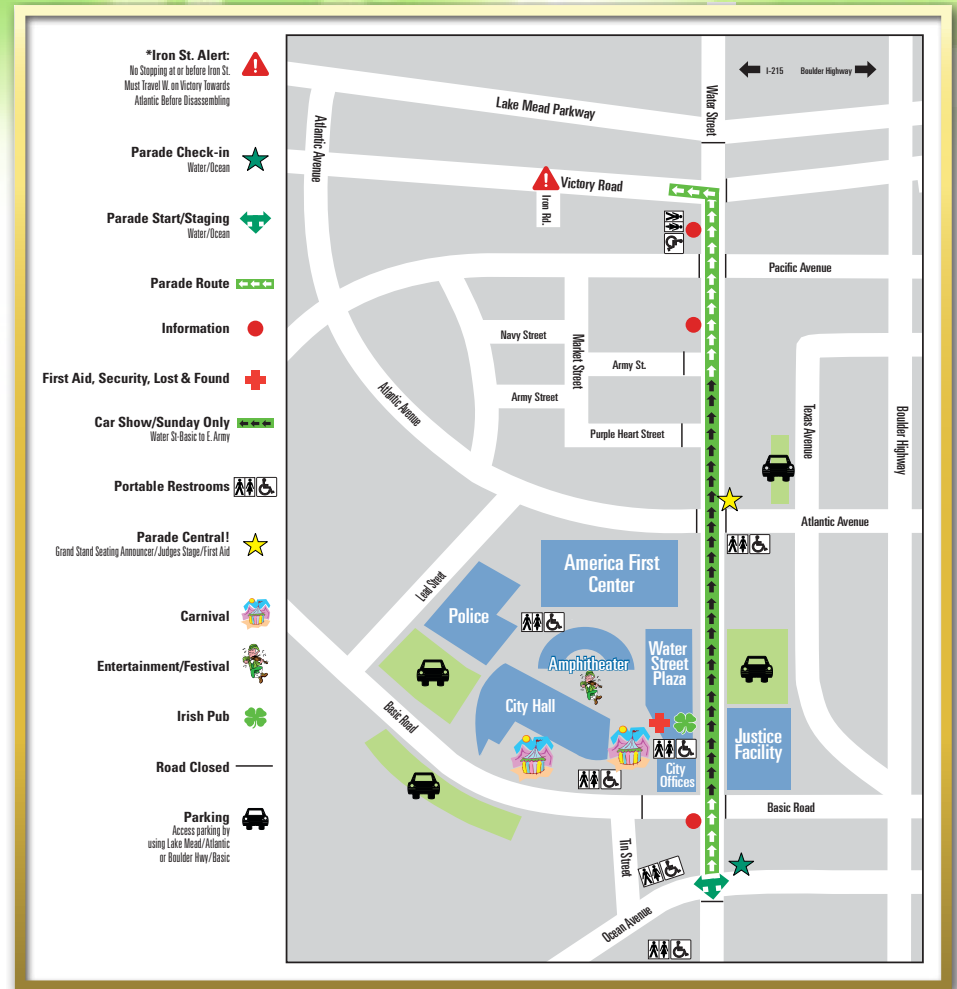

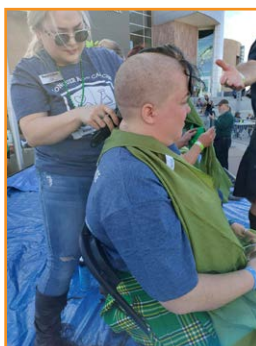


# Brave a Shave For Kid's Cancer Research!

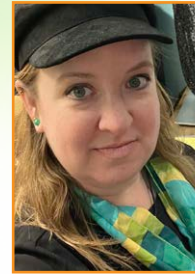
