

HENDERSON FIRE DEPARTMENT STATION 92

STATION:

- 2.85 acres at the corner of Larson Lane and Via Centro
- More than 14,000 square feet
- Four apparatus bays
- Equipment and supply storage
- Accommodations for up to fourteen firefighters
- Fitness room

SERVICE:

- Currently more than 10,200 residents in the service area
- Within the next five years, the number of residents is expected to grow to 24,500
- Estimated 1,053 calls by the end of 2024
- Estimated 1,740 annual calls by the end of 2029

CONSTRUCTION FACTS:

- Designed by Carpenter Sellers Del Gato Architects
- CORE Construction is the General Contractor
- Construction budget: 16.1 million
- Estimated completion is Spring 2025
- Last HFD Station was Station 87 in Cadence, completed in December 2022

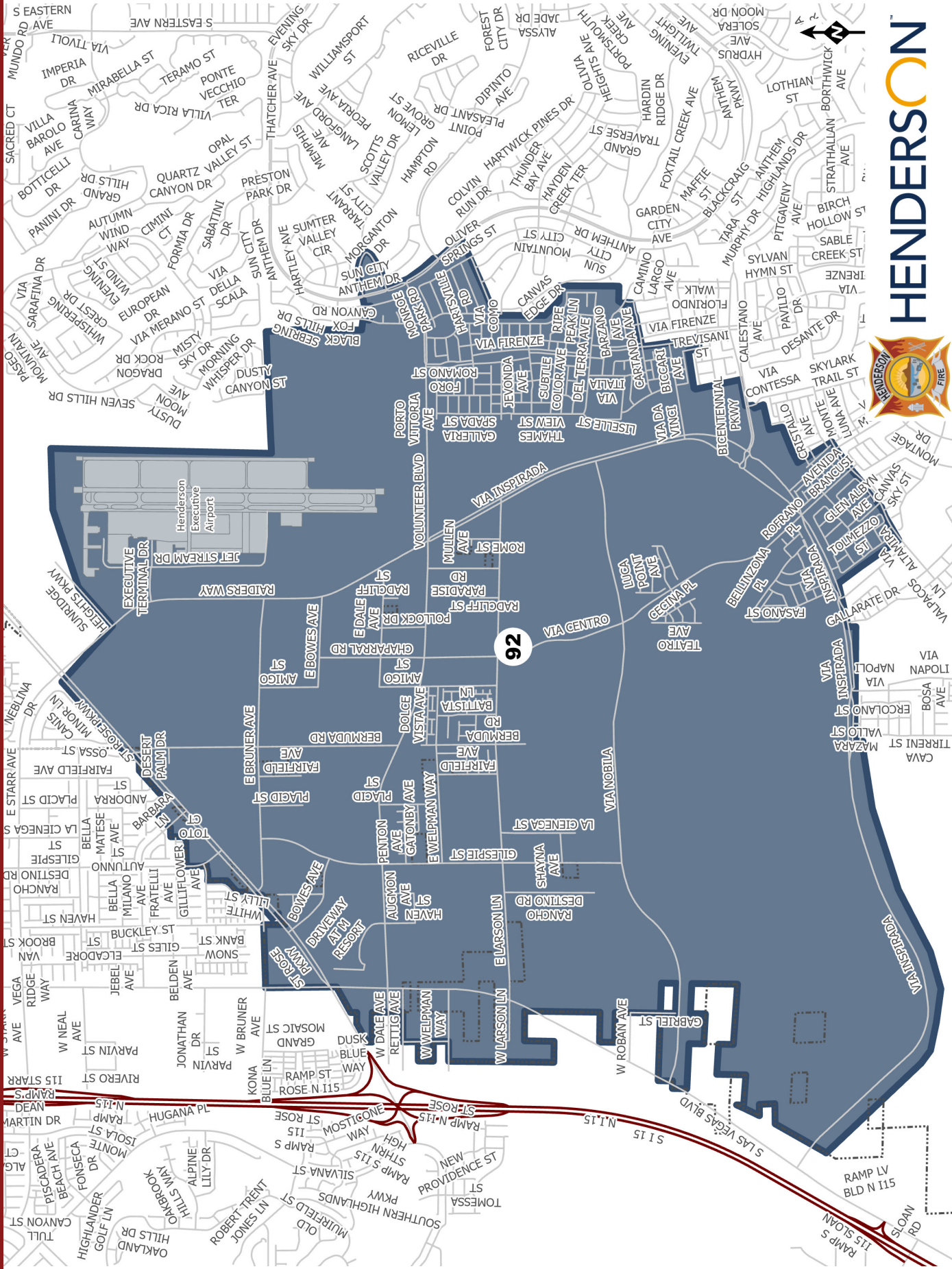
CHARACTERISTICS:
