The nationally certified **Building and Fire Safety Division** of the Community Development and Services Department performs plans check and inspections for conformity with building codes. Staff aids residents and the development community with inquiries regarding processing requirements, inspection, plan review inquiries and building and fire codes. The division, with the assistance of the Development Services Center, maintains records of all building permits and documents by address for public record as well.
